Florida


- The best climate can be found in Florida, there are tropical and semi-tropical regions.

- Before giant resort hotels could line Miami Beach, the island itself had to be created by dredging.






Washington

- The exterior walls made of sandstone were painted, causing the building to be termed the "White House".






Washington

- The Lincoln Memorial
- It is a square, Pantheon-like white building with columns around it.
- There is a large statue of Abraham Lincoln
- Washington Monument
- It is the white marble obelisk that rises in the middle of the Mall.
- There are eight small windows, two on each side of the pyramidal apex of the obelisk to overlook the whole area.
