The Pacific West

- Washington, Idaho, Oregon, North California + San Francisco
- High mountains /over 4 000 m/ many old volcanos, but not erupting any more
- Sequoas /redwood trees/, deep forests with the highest trees in the world
- Industry often based on timber
- San Francisco lies on steep mountains, cars climb up criss cross steep narrow streets
- Partly situated on a peninsula the Golden Gate Bridge – a wonderful construction








The Desert

- Lack of water
- Survival in the whole region depends on control of water
- Even the Indians made a lot for irrigation, some of their irrigation works are used even today
- New water projects made this region one of the bussiest places in the USA
- Water is piped into cities especially from the Colorado River, sometimes even from the north of California



The most famous desert cities



L.A. - Los Angeles

- There are stories of how the city got control of so much water.
- Almost 90 per cent of its water is piped from long distances.
- In spite of that there are many swimming pools in privat gardens, there is enough water for all the beautiful lawns /see the picture/

The gambling city, the casinos are open 24 hours a day

Salt Lake City

- The host city of Winter Olympic Games in 2002.





DEATH VALLEY N.P.


- Named by first people /called pioneers/, who crossed in in 1849.

- Rests of an old settlement /called pueblo/ situated safely high in a large rock
- Includes an old irrigation system
